Nursing Licensure Flipgrid Assignment
(50 points and 8% of the overall course grade)
Assignment Guidelines and Rubric

For this assignment, students are to demonstrate the new knowledge they have gained and share some reflections, after completing the learning activities focused on Nursing Licensure and State Boards of Nursing. This assignment will be completed as an oral presentation using Flipgrid, like how the introductions were completed in Week One. Resources are available in the Course Documents and Resource area of the course. This assignment is due by 11:59 pm Saturday of Week Three.

To complete this assignment, students are to record an oral presentation on the content items enumerated below. Because this is an oral presentation with a video component, grading in the mechanics section of the assignment will be slightly different this week. Students should provide a focused presentation in a setting appropriate for the assignment, in a scholarly manner. The presentation will be graded on the following criteria:

CONTENT: (40 points total)

1. NURSING LICENSURE – Explain how a nurse becomes licensed. Also, explain why licensure is important. (9 points)
2. BOARDS OF NURSING – Detail what the purpose of a Board of Nursing is. Share why Boards of Nursing are important. (8 points)
3. LICENSE MAINTENANCE – Discuss what a nurse needs to do to maintain their license. Provide at least one example of an action a nurse would do to maintain their licensure that would be acceptable in your home state. (8 points)
4. NURSE PRACTICE ACT – Share what the nurse practice act is, what it does, and why it is important. (9 points)
5. PEER COMMENTARY – This requirement is not a part of the initial submission and can be completed any time before 11:59 pm Sunday of Week Three. Students are to provide commentary on a minimum of one peer submission. The commentary must highlight a minimum of one new item learned from reviewing the submission. (6 points)

MECHANICS and CREATIVITY: (10 points)

1. The author's message is clearly conveyed.
2. The environment where the recording was completed was scholarly and appropriate for the assignment.
3. The presentation itself was scholarly.
4. The tone is appropriate for a scholarly assignment.

Missed Exams/Assignments

Assignments must be submitted on or before the due date posted by the course faculty. Students must contact course faculty PRIOR to the assignment due date for approval to submit assignments late. Two points per day may be deducted from late assignments. Assignments submitted late without faculty approval may receive a grade of zero (0).
